Imagine one in three members of your community living paycheck to paycheck. Unfortunately, this is the reality in Monmouth and Ocean counties as 37% of families are struggling to make ends meet. It's also what drives our organization every day.

Over the past year, we have made significant strides to help our neighbors by developing partnerships, mobilizing resources and implementing innovative programs focused on education, financial stability, health, and basic needs. We filled gaps, supported existing efforts, and ensured equity and access for those most in need. Examples of our work include:

- **Youth Career Pathways** – we helped students at Toms River High Schools develop a vision and plan of their future through pre-vocational hands-on education and training. Since the project launched, student participation in vocational programs from High School South has grown nearly 20%.
- **Access to Health/School-based Resources** – Health is a critical component of youth success and the ability to learn. Through our partnership with the VNA of Central Jersey School-Based Nurse Practitioners provide primary health care to students directly in local schools – expanding access for underserved students.
- **Basic Needs Initiative** – this expanding critical project helps struggling families extend their limited income by providing household and hygiene items distributed through a network of community partners. Since its inception we've provided over 135,000 household & hygiene essentials.

We are also proud to announce that United Way of Monmouth and Ocean Counties has been recognized for our transparency and effectiveness by Charity Navigator, earning a platinum rating. This highest-level accolade is a testament to our dedication to accountability and our relentless pursuit of excellence in all that we do. It reinforces the trust you have placed in us and underscores our commitment to maximizing the impact of every donation we receive.

None of our achievements would have been possible without the incredible generosity and support from our donors and volunteers. Their contributions have empowered us to make meaningful changes and touch countless lives. From the bottom of our hearts, we thank them for their continued support and belief in our mission.

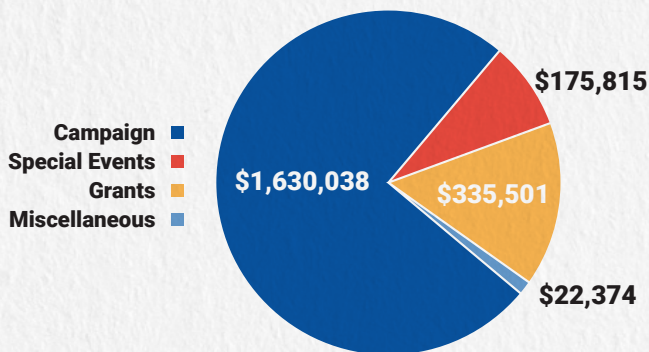

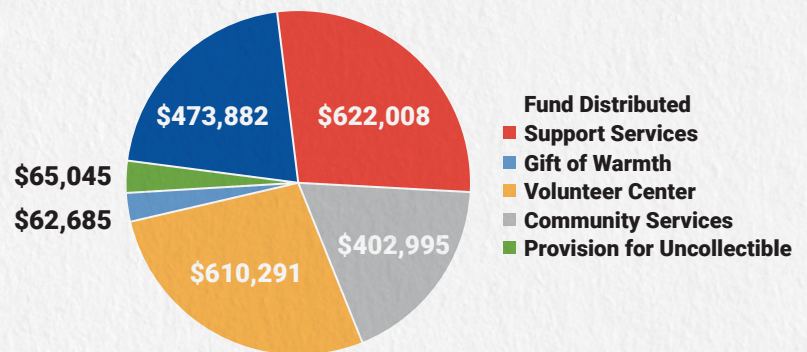
